Watching over San Francisco since 1937, the Golden Gate Bridge, often veiled in fog with only the two towers peeking through, stands over San Francisco Bay like a guardian angel. The fog gives the bridge an air of mystery and serene beauty that makes it nearly as breathtaking as it is in the sunshine, but nothing compares to the moment you crest the right hill in San Francisco on a clear day and see the bridge against the blue sky, the sparkling bay, the rolling Marin headlands and the Pacific Ocean beyond. It's a stunning site that never gets old, even for life-long San Franciscans.

The places to get a good view are many: For thrills, take a helicopter tour; head to the Presidio for sea-level views that make the bridge look colossal; bike or walk across it for the ultimate experience; or drive up to the vista points on the Marin side to get photos with San Francisco in the background.
